

## WINNING TRIO OF WORLD-CLASS ARTISTS!!!

Both **Doc Severinsen** and **Mariachi Los Camperos de Nati Cano** are Grammy-Award Winning Artists that tour the world annually presenting their unique styles of music, while **101 Years of Broadway** will feature five vocalists that have each performed leading roles on Broadway. The three-concert series will offer a variety of artists that should appeal to concertgoers of all ages. The first artist featured on November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, will be MARIACHI LOS CAMPEROS de Nati Cano. The Ann Arbor News (Michigan) recently described a performance by this dazzling ensemble as, "Powered by subtle yet forceful bass lines, harmonized trumpet charts and syncopated violin

arrangements, nearly every song featured at least one moment of jaw-dropping instrumental or vocal brilliance!"

In February of 2011, Neil Berg's 101 YEARS OF BROADWAY will hit the stage with a two-hour "rock concert" for Broadway fans.
