Carnac the Magnificent, Art Fern, Floyd R. Turbo, and Stump the Band are just a few of the characters and sketches developed by this famous trio that have impacted late night television in our country.



Doc Severinsen will be performing only three nights in the State of Texas ... one night in Houston and two nights in Boerne, Texas. Doc Severinsen, the mastermind of the music for The Tonight Show, is scheduled to bring this wit and unparalleled musicianship to Boerne Champion High School this Sunday (May 8th) and Monday, May 9th. Hill Country residents have the opportunity to hear this high note virtuoso, genuinely funny man and fashion fiend, in two evening performances, with his current touring ensemble, Doc Severinsen and the San Miguel 5. Showtime is at 7:30pm with pre-concert lobby presentations by Champion High School Band and Choir students prior to the show. The BISD Visual Arts Department will display works throughout the lobby for viewing prior to the concert, during intermission, and following the show.

Cathie Meadows, Lead Fine Arts Teacher at BISD, is most excited about bringing the professional performing arts to Boerne. “The inspiration that has been provided by the first two KPAS presentations in Boerne has been incredible! When asked about retirement, Doc leaves a very clear impression...“He is NOT ready to hang up his horn nor his traveling shoes.” Doc will join Gil Gutierrez, guitarist and composer, Charlie Bisharat (violin), Jimmy Branly (Percussion), and Kevin Thomas (Bass) to present an evening of jazz with a classical Spanish flair, gorgeous American and Latino ballads, and gypsy jazz, ala Django Reinhardt.
