Your opportunity to be onstage with five Broadway stars is only 90 seconds away...with the chance to perform on stage in ***Neil Berg's 101 Years of Broadway*** at the Boerne-Champion High School Auditorium on February 17-18, 2011. Auditions are now being accepted on YouTube, MySpace, and Facebook for your chance to be featured with five of the finest voices on Broadway, stars of such hit shows as *Les Miserables*, *Phantom of the Opera*, *Jekyll and Hyde*, *Beauty and the Beast*, *Jesus Christ Superstar*, and many more. Neil Berg, one of the busiest guys in showbiz, will be the featured pianist/producer for a two-hour extravaganza highlighting a headliner cast of Broadway Stars performing favorites from The Great White Way. Berg is the composer/lyricist of the hit Off-Broadway musical "The Prince and the Pauper," which ran for two years at the Lambs Theater in New York City; the composer for the new Broadway-bound musical "Grumpy Old Men," based on the Warner Brothers movie classic starring Jack Lemmon and Walter Matthau, and scheduled to open in 2010/2011; and is collaborating with Pulitzer Prize winning playwright Robert Schenkkan on a new rock musical called "The 12".

The panel will judge the audition tapes to decide the lucky winners who will get the chance to show off their singing skills in front of their family and friends with five Broadway stars and an all-star New York Band. The panel will announce the winners on February 11, 2011, working through local presenter Kerrville Performing Arts Society, presenters of the finest professional performing arts in the Texas Hill Country.
